<i>Melaleuca squarrosa</i>	Scented paperbark	Shrub to 4m
<i>Platylobium formosum</i>	Handsome flat pea	To 1m
<i>Pultenaea stricta</i>	Ridge bush pea	Shrub to 0.5m
<i>Stylidium graminifolium</i>	Trigger plant	Tufted perennial to 0.3m

<i>Dillwynia sericea</i>	Showy Parrot Pea	Shrub to 1m
<i>Diplarrena moraea</i>	Butterfly Flag	Shrub to 1m
<i>Epacris microphylla</i>	Short flowered heath	Shrub to 1m
<i>Hakea nodosa</i>	Yellow Hakea	Shrub to 2m
<i>Hakea teretifolia</i>	Dagger Hakea	Shrub to 1.5m
<i>Hakea ulicina</i>	Furze Hakea	Shrub to 2m

<i>Leptospermum continentale</i>	Prickly Tea tree	Shrub to 3m
<i>Melaleuca ericifolia</i>	Swamp Paperbark	Shrub to 4m
<i>Ozothamnus ferrugineus</i>	Tree Everlasting	Shrub to 3m
<i>Pattersonia occidentalis</i>	Purple Flag Lily	Tufted perennial to 0.5m
<i>Polyscias sambucifolia</i>	Elderberry Panax	Shrub to 2m
<i>Pultenaea daphnoides</i>	Wedge leaf bush pea	Shrub to 3m
<i>Solanum aviculare</i>	Kangaroo Aple	Shrub to 3m
<i>Themeda triandra</i>	Kangaroo grass	Tufted perennial to 0.5m
<i>Viminaria juncea</i>	Golden Spray	Tree to 3m
<i>Xanthorrhoea minor</i>	Small Grass Tree	Tufted perennial to 0.5m
